Castercote is heavy duty trolley oil for use in batch or tank systems in beef slaughter plants. Castercote is formulated to adhere to metal surfaces under condition of extreme heat and moisture.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Dip trolleys in a tank of hot oil (160°F-180°F) for a minimum of 10 seconds. Let the excess oil drip off. For more information, please contact your Safe Foods Chemical Innovations' Representative. Before use in federally inspected meat and poultry food processing plants and dairies, food products and packaging materials must be removed from room or carefully protected.

Additional Precautions: Avoid water contamination and extreme temperature to minimize product degradation. Partially full or emptied container may contain vapors which may support combustion.
