RE: Sterilex Ultra Step

This is in reply to your submission dated April 12, 2016, wherein you requested our comments on the acceptability of the subject product for use as a sanitizer for non-food contact surfaces such as floors, floor mats and boots in food processing establishments, on behalf of Sterilex Corporation

Based on the information provided, we can advise that we see no reason to object to its use as proposed for use in food processing establishments, provided that:

- a) There will be no contamination of food as a result of its use and storage; and
- b) Prior to the application of the product in food handling areas, all food and food contact surfaces should be removed from the product's application vicinity or protected.

With respect to the label of the product, the label contains adequate directions for use of the product regarding the non-food contact surfaces applications. For other applications such as use in footbaths, please note that our evaluations focus only on food safety, for uses of the product as a skin product, please contact the Cosmetics Division of the Consumer Product Safety Directorate of the Healthy Environments and Consumer Safety Branch of Health Canada at
